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

FIRST AID MEASURES

Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed:

The most important known symptoms and effects are described in the labelling (see Section 2) and/or Section 11.

Fluorides, found in Cryolite (Na3(AlF6)) may cause salivation, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal pain, followed by weakness, tremors, shallow respiration, convulsions and coma.

Chronic, repeated exposure through inhalation may have an effect on the bones and teeth, resulting in fluorosis, weight loss, anorexia, anemia and dental defects.

Swallowing large amounts of Cryolite (Na3(AIF6)) dust will lead to a strong corrosive effect on the mouth and throat which may lead to perforation of the esophagus and stomach. Because of the likely corrosive effects on the gastrointestinal tract after ingestion, evacuating stomach contents via emesis or gastric lavage should be avoided.
